To create an intimate gallery space and still give a sense of the presence of the staff, the entrance wall was built of translucent corrugated fiberglass panels. Activities in the office become shadowlike movements, leaving activities obscure, at the same time evoking curiosity. The office partitions themselves are 'soft' walls, to be used as pinboards, to be touched, and to absorb sound. Fluorescent lights create a barrier between the public and the office space, and simultaneously signal the presence of the gallery on the street.
